Joe: (*pleading*) Dad, can I stay up to watch something special on the TV tonight?

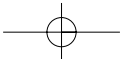
Dad: I don't know, it depends on what it is ...

Mum: (*coming into the room*) ... And what time it finishes.



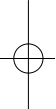
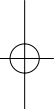


20 horizontal lines for writing.
